Kendall Christian School offers the following after school programs for our students:

Art Club with Mrs. Fonseca is an after school club for students who want to draw, paint, and create. In this club students will explore various media including pastels, acrylics on canvas, water colors and more. They will also learn fun drawing techniques. The program is structured but relaxed and is designed to teach the kids self-worth, self-control, and vision. K4 students meet on Monday from 3:20-4:20 PM and K5 thru 5th grade meets on Fridays for 12 weeks (9/9 - 12/2). Cost: \$250 (all materials included)

They will also learn to predict, based on the book cover and tell what the story will be about, as well as, what might happen next or how the story will end. Little Me Spanish Club with Mrs. Golindano is designed for K2 students where they will play and learn in Spanish. The club meets every Friday from 3:30-4:05 PM for 12 weeks (9/6 - 12/6). Cost: \$270 (all materials included)

Travelers Reading Club with Mrs. Cristino is an after school club designed for students to learn that there are characters and settings (where and when it takes place) in stories. Your child will enjoy comparing the characters, in a book, to themselves and to other real-life people they have encountered in their lives. The child will also be able to identify books that are fiction from nonfiction. This promotes critical thinking. The club is designed for K3 - K5 students. They will meet every Thursday from 3:30-4:05 PM for 12 weeks (9/5-12/5). Cost: \$270 (all materials included) 10 students min.

Yearbook Club with Mrs. Portas is an after school club for students in 4th - 5th grade. They will help design the 2019-2020 school yearbook. The students will write articles for our school yearbook. This club will meet once a month from September through May on Wednesdays from 3:30-4:30 PM. Cost: Free
