We appreciate your interest in joining Camp Kendall! (Prek3-Middle School)

Camp Kendall will offer many fun activities, including field trips for campers in 1st through Middle and special on-site events for all campers. **There are several opt-in field trips scheduled for Kindergarten campers.**

Our summer camp is open to the community for students entering K5 – Middle.

Existing and newly accepted KCS students entering K3 in the fall may apply (must be potty trained).

New this year: Camp Kendall Pre-K Edition:

Our Preschool-Kindergarten campers will be housed together in the same wing with a designated camp director for our younger campers. The calendar of events for things like dress-up days, etc., will run the same as the elementary. However, these campers' activities will be tailored for our youngest campers. Kindergarten campers will also have opt-in travel field trip opportunities.

CAMP KENDALL INFORMATION (GENERAL CAMP):

- **CAMP DATES:** June 10th - July 26th
- **CAMP HOURS:** 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM
- **REGISTRATION FEE: \$100 Due at the enrollment** (*One-time Fee, includes a camp T-shirt and bag*)
- **WEEKLY FEE:** \$300 (Includes lunch, field trips, and all activities)
- **WEEKS MUST BE PRESELECTED – No Deposit Required**
- **BEFORE AND AFTERCARE:** Additional \$50.00 weekly.

SPECIALTY MINI-CAMPS PROGRAM:

Apart from our general camp, we offer specialty mini-camps for **K4 - elementary grades**. (i.e., Robotics Camp, Art Camp, etc.)

Campers who enroll in a specialty camp will remain in that mini-camp for the entire week. **Please pay close attention to the weeks they are being offered and the grade requirement to attend.**

- **SPECIALTY MINI-CAMP HOURS:** 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM
- **SPECIALTY MINI-CAMP FEE:** \$200 for the week (Chef Kat Camp \$250)
- **Includes Lunch and Materials**
- **Before and Aftercare is NOT available for campers attending a specialty camp.**

SPECIALTY MINI-CAMPS:

Summer Art Studio: Join us in the summer studio as we dive into the underwater world of art, creating artwork based on famous artists such as Guy Harvey, Wyland, and more! Each day, we will use various mediums to create different wonders found within the seas. From plaster to paint, campers will enjoy hands-on experiences creating new works of art.

Grades: Incoming 2nd – 5th grade (Week 1)

Spanish Fun Camp: “Hola, bienvenidos al maravilloso *Mundo del Español!*” This mini-camp aims to introduce a second language through interactive games, music, stories, and practical activities. Let’s make the most of our little one’s developing brain while it is most receptive to learning multiple languages. You may sign up for one, two, or all three weeks.

Grades: Incoming K4/K5 (Weeks 1, 2 & 3)

Life Skills: Life skills are essential for navigating through daily challenges and achieving personal growth. During this mini-camp, we will work on areas such as dealing with emotions, communicating with their peers, etiquette, maintaining organized and clean rooms, dressing for success, and more. Expect a time to grow and learn while having fun!

Grades: Incoming 1st – 4th Grade (Weeks 2, 6 & 7)

Just Girly Things: Get ready for a girl's mini-camp like it's 1999. We will make friendship bracelets, sing karaoke, have fun with tie-dye, learn to braid hair, have fun with journaling, create girly crafts, and more!

Grades: Incoming 1st-4th (Weeks 2 & 3)

VEX IQ Robotics: This summer, campers can participate in robotics challenges, including robot building, VEX Code programming, and 3D printing using Tinkercad. They will apply the Engineering Design process to build a VEX IQ robot and compete with other teams on the last day of the mini-camp.

Grades: Incoming 3rd-5th Grade (Week 3)

Cooking with Chef Kat: A weeklong hands-on cooking camp taught by Chef Kat, a former Chef at the Biltmore Hotel with 11 years of experience. In this program, kids can actively participate in the preparation and discover the joy of creating delicious meals. They will learn knife skills and food safety and cook cuisines from different countries daily. Along our journey, we’ll gain an understanding of the food culture of these different regions. Always working with fresh ingredients and herbs. It is a great opportunity for your child to gain and develop new culinary skills. ***Please note this camp is at a higher rate of \$250 per week.***

Grades: Incoming 3rd – Middle School (Weeks 1,5 & 6)
